Automated Payment Checklist

An automated payment (or ACH) is a regular, ongoing payment that is initiated externally to your bank account, such as a monthly insurance bill, utility payment or car loan payment. To switch automatic payments currently set-up to debit your checking, savings, debit or credit card to your new account, use the Automated Payments Checklist below. This is a good time to review your last few monthly bank statements to complete your list of authorized automatic payments. Take into consideration any annual payments that you may have set up as a deduction, as well.
